Assessor Programmes

The LC Partnership Ltd Assessor suite of qualifications provides learners with high quality, nationally recognised qualifications. They are vocationally related, credit-based qualifications that provide valuable opportunities for individuals to develop skills, underpinning knowledge and understanding and demonstrate competence in the workplace or provide progression to the Level 4 Internal Quality Assurance of Assessment Processes and Practice.

This course will be delivered by LC Partnership Ltd and will combine an online-tutorial session, followed by a 12-week distance self-directed learning supported by an online tutor. To support you in achieving your Assessor qualification, LC Partnership Ltd have developed a set of assignments and activities to enable you to demonstrate your knowledge, understanding and your Assessor performance. The activities and the type of documentation you may want to use are set out as part of this programme outline. The programme is fast paced and if you put the effort in, you should be able to complete it within 2 to 12 weeks, depending on which Pathway you choose to enrol on.

Depending on which pathway you choose, the Assessor Programmes are aimed at learners who either want to understand the fundamental principles of assessment or who want to practice as an Assessor. This qualification is designed for learners aged 19 and above. There are not any specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification. However, learners might find it helpful if they have achieved a previous Level 3 qualification.

- Pathway 1 – Level 3 Award in Understanding the Principles and Practices of Assessment (RQF) (Credit Value 3), which consists of one unit and understanding of the principles and practices of assessment without any requirement to practice as assessors:
- Pathway 2 – Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment (RQF) (Credit Value 9), which consists of two units, the theory unit, and it includes an ability for individuals to demonstrate assessment performance using a wide range of assessment methods. Anyone achieving this award will enable them to perform assessment activities within a work environment and licence to practice as a vocational assessor:

- Pathway 3 - Level 3 Award in Assessing Vocationally Related Achievement (RQF) (Credit Value 9), which consists of two units, the theory unit, and a demonstration of performance practical unit. This qualification is intended for those who assess vocational skills, knowledge and understanding in environments other than the work environment (for example a workshop, classroom or other training environment). It will enable individuals to perform assessment activities within a wide range of activities such as; assessment of learners in a simulated environment, learners doing skills test, oral, written or multi choice questioning, assignments, projects etc.
- Pathway 4 - Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement (RQF) (Credit Value 15), which consists of all three units. This qualification is intended for those who assess both occupational competence in the work environment and vocational skills, knowledge and understanding in environments other than the workplace (for example a workshop, classroom or other training environment). Anyone achieving this award will enable them to perform assessment activities in a working environment and classroom, workshop or other training environment.

- *Pathway 3 - Level 4 Certificate in Leading the External Quality Assurance of Assessment Processes and Practice (Credit Value 17)*, which consist of three units, the theory unit, a demonstration of performance practical unit and a demonstration that you lead several other EQAs. Like Pathway 2, achieving this certificate will qualify you as qualified EQA and licence to practice:



Education and Training Programmes

The LC Partnership Ltd Education and Training qualifications provides learners with high quality, nationally recognised qualifications. They are vocationally related, credit-based qualifications that provide valuable opportunities for individuals to develop skills, underpinning knowledge and understanding and demonstrate competence in the workplace or provide progression to the Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training.

These qualifications are aimed at those who work, or want to work as teachers/trainers in the further education and skills sector, including those who are not in a teaching role, or who have just started a teaching role, and include Award-size qualifications for those who want a short qualification to enable them to make career choices.

- *Level 3 Award in Education and Training (Credit Value 12)*, is an introduction to teaching that will give an insight into the roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training, how to plan and deliver inclusive teaching sessions and how to assess and give constructive feedback.
- *Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training (Credit Value 36)*, is a first stage teaching qualification which has a teaching/training practice requirement. It is designed for those working or wishing to work as teachers/trainers in England. It may also be possible for pre-service teachers/trainers (defined as those who are not formally contracted as teachers/trainers) to also complete this qualification. All candidates, whether pre-service or in-service must have access to 30 hours of teaching. This qualification is also suitable for those delivering education and training in any learning environment.

Candidates who successfully complete this qualification will have a fundamental understanding of the roles and responsibilities of a teacher/trainer in relation to legislation, equality, diversity, inclusivity and meeting the needs of learners. They will be able to use initial and diagnostic assessments and plan and deliver inclusive teaching and learning. They will also be able to assess learning and use appropriate resources to support effective learning.

- *Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training (Credit Value 120)*, is a teaching qualification which has a teaching/training practice requirement. It is an 'in service' qualification designed for those working or wishing to work as teachers/trainers in England. It may also be possible for pre-service teachers/trainers (defined as those who are not formally contracted as teachers/trainers) to also complete this qualification. All candidates, whether pre-service or in-service must have access to 100 hours of teaching.

Candidates who successfully complete this qualification will take an analytical and practical approach to all aspects of planning, delivering and assessing inclusive teaching and learning. Whilst doing this, candidates will embed theories and principles in education and training and demonstrate them in their practice.
